Check-In and Schedule

- We will be utilizing a "self-check-in" process the morning of each test. Please look for your team's number and park your cart in the designated spot. You number, catalog, and other materials will be in this space.
- Any move-ups MUST be communicated to the secretary at least 30 minutes before the equipment check begins.
- Check-in and equipment check times will be determined after the close of entries. All teams (including alternates) will be contacted via email with these details. Test site will open at least 30 minutes prior to check-in time.
- Course walk-through will take place following equipment check.
- Judging to begin as soon as possible after the walk-through.
- Lunch break will be taken at the judges' discretion.
- Awards will be presented at the conclusion of the test each day.

Awards

Each passing team at each test will receive a Berner-themed award and a rosette. Teams earning new titles will receive an additional rosette with a "tag ribbon" to indicate the title earned. A ring favor will be given to each participating team as the exit the draft ring (before the group stay and freight haul exercises).

We Welcome Spectators

We encourage individuals not entered in the tests to attend, observe and ask questions! Spectators may bring un-entered dog(s) with them, but they must be leashed or crated and under control at all times. Please show courtesy to the working teams by keeping dogs at a reasonable distance away from the ring, and please do not allow them to foul the freight haul course. Please remember to pick up after your dog(s).

Bernese Mountain Dog Club of America Draft Test Purpose

The Bernese Mountain Dog Club of America (BMDCA) Draft Tests are a series of exercises designed to develop and demonstrate the natural abilities of purebred Bernese Mountain Dogs in a working capacity involving hauling. The Bernese Mountain Dog has historically functioned as a draft dog in various capacities, and performance of these exercises is intended to demonstrate skills resulting from both inherent ability and training which are applicable to realistic work situations. It is also desirable that the dog evidence willingness and enjoyment of his work in a combination of controlled teamwork with his handler and natural independence.

Class Entry Details

- There will be a limit of 24 entries for each of the two Draft Tests.
- Entry Fees: \$40 for each single dog team; \$45 for a brace team.
- A separate entry form must be filled out for each dog of a brace team and then submitted together. Even though two entry forms are required for each brace team, each brace team will be counted as one entry in the Draft Test entry limit.
- If entries exceed the Test limit, entry priority shall be given in the following order:
 - 1. Untitled BMDs
 - 2. Titled BMDs without Advanced/Master titles in the entered class
 - **3.** Titled BMDs with Advanced/Master titles in the entered class
 - 4. Untitled other dogs
 - 5. Titled other dogs without Advanced/Master titles in the entered class
 - **6.** Titled other dogs with Advanced/Master titles in the entered class

*Note: For brace teams, the dog with the lowest level title in the entered class determines the team's priority. If a brace team has a BMD and a non-BMD, it is considered a "BMD Team" for the above.

- *Note that "titled" means titled in the entered class.
- Running Order: A separate random draw to determine the running order for each class for each test.
- Entrants must notify the Draft Test Secretary if a dog has earned a title in the entered class, including if the title is earned after the entry has been submitted.

Attention Exhibitors

- The following classes will be offered: Novice, Brace Novice, Open and Brace Open.
- Handlers must provide their own rigs, harnesses and tie downs or other means of securing a load in their particular draft rig.
- Handlers much bring their own weight. Weight will be verified via scale at the test site.
- Entered dogs must be 24 months old or older on the day of the Draft Test
 Bitches in season are not permitted to compete. Refunds will be given for bitches in season or inured dogs with a veterinary certificate required at the discretion of the club. It is requested that the Draft Test Secretary be notified by telephone and/or e-mail if a withdrawal from the test(s) is necessary for any reason.
- The two dogs of a brace team need not be owned by the same person or by the handler.
- Unentered dogs may be present but, like entered dogs who are not in the ring, must be leashed or crated and under control
 at all times.
- Please remember to be responsible dog owners and pick up after your dog(s).

Weight Certificates

Each Open or Open Brace entry shall include the DWC weight certificate(s) or a certificate that includes the same information that is contained in the DWC Weight Certificate (included at the end of this Premium List and also available on the BMDCA website) and be signed and dated within 60 days prior to each Draft Test date. The handler is solely responsible for having a valid Weight Certificate. An incorrect Weight Certificate may result in the loss of any qualifying runs.

Regulations

Entrants are responsible for obtaining the BMDCA Draft Test Regulations (revised as of January, 2023) and being familiar with them.

NOTE: The BMDCA website is currently being rebuilt, and the latest version of the Draft Test Regulations may not be available there. If a copy is needed, please request it from the Draft Test Chair via email. A PDF version of these regulations will be sent in reply, including a bullet point list of changes from the previous version.

About The Test Site

Ample parking on asphalt is available. The test site includes access to a climate-controlled building which includes a kitchen area and restrooms. Adequate crating space for all participants' dogs is available in this building. A protective tarp (or similar) is required to be placed under all crates set up in this building.

The building is not immediately adjacent to the test ring – the entrance is approximately 200 yards from the test ring site. Shade is limited, so, if desired, portable cover/canopies can be set up on the grounds closer to the test ring site for use instead of (or in addition to) the building.

Sign(s) will be posted on Williams Road to indicate the entrance to the club. Please use your preferred map application for directions to the test site.

Pre-Test Setup

Between the hours of 3PM and 6PM on Friday, September 29th, you may set up crates and chairs in the building, set up portable cover/canopies, and bring your cart to the test site. Carts may be stored in the building overnight (provided wheels are free of mud). The site is private property, and the entrance gate will be locked each evening, but you assume all risk for any belongings left at the site.

Refreshments & Lunch

Morning hospitality (coffee, bottled water, breakfast snacks) will be available both days, with donations gratefully accepted. A box lunch will be available for purchase both days of the testing weekend. Orders and payment will be taken the morning of each test.

Weather

Please consult your favorite weather report or app for the most accurate weather information close to the dates of the tests. The weather can be unpredictable, so please come prepared.

Silent Auction

A silent auction will take place during the draft test weekend, featuring multiple baskets filled with fantastic prizes. A larger item or two (i.e. a draft cart) may be included as one of the prizes. The silent auction will end at a pre-announced time on Sunday afternoon. Winners need to be present in order to receive their prize, or plan for a friend to claim and deliver the prize to you.

Judges' Dinner

A judges' dinner will be held on Saturday evening, September 30th, at a local dining establishment close to the test site. Everyone is invited to attend this event to honor our judges. Orders will be taken from the menu with attendees responsible for their individual food and drink cost.
